Package Description:	<p>At the time of publishing this invitation to submit an Expression Of Interest (EOI), the Scope of this package covers the construction of the 30Mtpa Ore Processing Facility consisting of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • primary crushing facility; • secondary crushing and screening building; • tertiary crushing building; and • plant conveyors. <p>These facilities will be designed by FMG and the construction contract will include, but not be limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • installation of concrete foundations; • shop detailing, supply, and installation of steel work – including (but not limited to) all structural members, dump truck bridges, material hoppers, transfer chutes, plant conveyor structures, handrails, and walkways; • supply and installation of all electrical cabling, cable trays, lighting, and field instrumentation; • supply and installation of raw and fire water reticulation systems including all valves and fittings; • supply and installation of conveyor componentry including drives, pulleys, idlers, belting, pull-wire, and take-up systems; • installation of major equipment as supplied by FMG, including gyratory crusher, sizers, cone crushers, apron feeder, belt feeders, pan feeders, vibrating screens, switch rooms, and transformers; and • commissioning of the facilities. <p>The Eliwana Project, including 751EWC0017 is subject to internal approvals.
