Scope of Work:	<p>Provision of Helicopter services for offshore personnel transfers, including provision of a dedicated Darwin operating base to support 24/7 Barossa Project construction and steady state operations post construction completion.</p> <p>Services will be delivered to several offshore vessels through Project construction and Floating Production Storage Offtake vessel (FPSO) hook up and commissioning prior to regular shift transfers through steady state operations.</p> <p>Vessels will be located in the Barossa Site footprint approximately 300km offshore north of Darwin, Northern Territory, within the Bonaparte Basin, located in the Timor Sea.</p> <p>Services will also include, provision of</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • medevac services, • drug and alcohol testing and bag searches prior to personnel mobilisation • full suite of maintenance, spare parts, fuel and consumables • search and rescue • down wire personnel • full suite of reporting, flight monitoring and statutory and regulatory compliance
Objectives:	<p>The main objectives for this source of interest and information are to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Explore availability of helicopter providers with local capacity to provide personnel transfers and medevac for the Barossa project periods from late 2020 through to 2024 and the operational requirement post-handover. 2. Enable ConocoPhillips to gather the latest market information on local helicopter providers and equipment availability to meet the specifications.
