Title: Construction Village Buildings, Utilities, Operations & Catering

Scope of Work: Bechtel recognises the intent of the City of Karratha to improve the economic future of the Pilbara and accordingly, the role of the City of Karratha in transient worker accommodation. In support of engineering and design work Bechtel is currently undertaking to progress Woodside's proposed Pluto Train 2, we are seeking expressions of interest for the provision of temporary workforce accommodation facilities and/or the operation of services to support site labour activities should the project progress. Bechtel is seeking to understand the potential for local and Indigenous employment and business participation as part of the expression of interest. The information we receive will directly inform our approach to our temporary workforce accommodation requirements.

The proposed aggregate required bed capacity is expected to be up to 2,500 at peak. The provision of this requirement may be furnished through one or more suppliers by use of existing, or new, facilities or a combination thereof. Key service requirements include:

- Kitchen consumables;
- Food items for three meals per day;
- Social facilities;
- Cooking hardware and utensils;
- Dinnerware and flatware;
- Grease disposal;
- Facility linens;
- Full resident laundry services;
- Operations and maintenance personnel for facility operation and upkeep including:
  - o Accommodation facility care;
  - o Mechanical maintenance associated with the facility;
  - o Grounds and landscaping;
  - o Staff quarters and housekeeping;
  - o Social facilities management and maintenance;
  - o Rubbish collection and disposal; and
  - o Retail services supply.

We plan that the temporary workforce accommodation facility will also include a medical facility for workforce personnel. We also plan to have 24/7 security at the temporary workforce accommodation facility to ensure only authorized personnel are granted access and appropriate security is maintained within the facility for the safety and well being of the workforce. We intend to work closely with the City to ensure our facility and workforce provide a positive impact on the community and do not adversely impact existing community clubs or facilities.
