- Established systems and procedures for the execution of MWS services for major offshore oil and gas projects.
- Knowledge of both Australian Standards and international recognised codes and standards commonly used for major offshore oil and gas projects.
- Secure Confidentiality Agreement with required parties for Barossa Offshore Project.
- Not provide any services to parties that would present a Conflict of Interest with Barossa Offshore Project MWS services.
