Title: Domestic Transport and Logistics Services

Scope of Work: The Logistics Service Provider (LSP) will operate an existing national warehouse, distribution and transportation network capable of handling approximately 2,500 semi-trailer truckloads over a three-year term. The LSP will execute three primary logistics functions for the project as follows:

1) Domestic Transport (Multimodal)

The LSP will provide all labour and equipment to provide Domestic Transport Services necessary to transport equipment and materials from various suppliers and facilities located throughout Australia for the project. The equipment and materials will be transported by the LSP via various modes (road predominantly, air & rail additionally) and deliver directly to the Pluto Train 2 Jobsite or other destinations as instructed.

2) Port/Airport to Site Domestic Transport

The LSP will provide all Domestic Transport Services necessary to collect or deliver equipment and materials to and from the various sea and air ports within Australia.

3) Less than a Trailer Load (LTL) Consolidation Point

The LSP will provide a consolidation facility in the Perth metropolitan area, large enough to receive and collect equipment and materials from suppliers and transport them to the Pluto Train 2 Jobsite or other destinations as instructed.

The LSP will have responsibility to:

- Provide suitable personnel and equipment to load/unload, handle, store and transport project equipment and materials while conforming to all relevant Federal, State or Territory law.
- Obtain any necessary permits/passes required for air/road/rail transport, port and airport access and for access to Pluto Train 2 Jobsite.
- When necessary, provide specialized equipment for cargo with oversize, over-mass, soft ride or temperature control requirements.
- Provide escort vehicles for all oversize or over-mass loads in accordance with the MRWA Pilot Vehicles and Pilots Code of Conduct.
- Receive/verify weights and number of packages delivered from Project suppliers.
- Highlight any discrepancies when packages are received from Project suppliers which are either incomplete or whose packaging is insufficient to ensure safe transport to Project jobsite.
- Provide a daily report in the required format (electronic – to be confirmed).
- Maintaining and enforcing Project's Safety Philosophy whilst adhering to all Site Safety Rules and Regulations while on Jobsite. The LSP will need to Demonstrate this with existing safety records.
- Supply all timber, dunnage, packing and securing material that is required to safely transport equipment to Jobsite.
- Provide suitable personnel and equipment for transportation, handling and storage of Dangerous Goods, complying with Australian Dangerous Goods Code (ADG Code), and all other relevant Federal, State or Territory law.
