

PROJECT SEA DRAGON – EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

<p>Project Overview</p>	<p>The proposed Project Sea Dragon (PSD) is a large-scale, integrated, land-based prawn aquaculture project in northern Australia that will deliver high-quality, year-round reliable volumes for export markets. PSD will be a staged development of ultimately up to 10,000 hectares of produce ponds, including the development of a series of facilities across northern Australia including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Genetics, breeding program and multiplication centre at Exmouth, Western Australia ■ Hatchery to be built at Point Ceylon, Bynoe Harbour, near Darwin, Northern Territory ■ Grow out ponds to be built at Legune Pastoral Lease, Northern Territory, approximately 100km from the town of Kununurra, Western Australia ■ Processing facility to be built approximately 15km north of Kununurra. <p>Seafarms has all the necessary regulatory approvals in place to build Stage 1 of the development with approximately 1,120 Ha of ponds plus the necessary associated upstream and downstream facilities. Seafarms proposes to develop Stage 1 in several steps with Step 1 of Stage 1 (S1S1) being one farm at Legune of approximately 400 Ha plus all the necessary upstream and downstream facilities at Legune and the other sites. It is anticipated the balance of Stage 1 would be complete within 3 years of commissioning S1S1 and that subsequent stages 2 to 10 would continue to roll on after that. However, the scope of this EOI is for Step 1 of Stage 1.</p> <p>PSD is in the process of securing debt funding from prospective financiers to fund the construction and initial operation of the Step 1 Stage 1. PSD is seeking Expressions of Interest from consultants to provide resources into an integrated Project Management Team for the purposes of managing the engineering, construction and commissioning phases of the project.</p> <p>Step 1 of Stage 1 of Project Sea Dragon has a total construction budget of approximately \$280M excluding cost contingency and escalation. Organisations interested in responding to this request for expression of interest are encouraged to review Seafarms (ASX – SFG) half year report and presentation released on the ASX site 28th February 2020.</p>

<p>Package Description</p>	<p>The roles will commence on or about 30 June 2020. The services will continue through the engineering, construction and commissioning periods of the project. The Integrated Project Management Team will consist of a combination of PSD staff and consultant professional staff to form an Integrated Project Management Team reporting to the PSD Project Director.</p> <p>The Integrated Project Management Team will be responsible for all aspects of the project including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Engineering noting the role is management of engineering done by others ■ Procurement

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Project Controls ■ Construction noting there will be no self-perform and the construction will be undertaken by contractors ■ Commissioning ■ Administration <p>The Integrated Project Management Team role will be carried out across multiple project locations. The main project management office will be located in Darwin with site offices at each of the four construction sites in WA and NT. It is expected that the project management team will be based in Darwin although other locations could be considered for specific work groups.</p> <p>The site-based personnel at our facilities near Exmouth, Bynoe and Kununurra can be serviced from the nearby townships. The Legune site however will require site-based personnel to live in ensuited single persons quarters while on roster at Legune (rosters still to be determined).</p> <p>Respondents to this EOI will be assessed and short listed, with short listed respondents to be invited to tender. Tenderers will be provided with access to project documentation including project execution plan, organisation chart, procurement management plan, and project controls plan.</p> <p>CV's should be provided for all roles normally performed by a project team and specifically the following roles</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Project Manager (reporting to the Project Director); ■ Site Manager Legune (Large Scale Remote Area); ■ Site Manager Bynoe (Medium Scale); ■ Contract Administrator; ■ Cost Engineer; and ■ other project roles including Senior Project Engineers, Project Engineers, procurement officer, document controller.
