Project Overview:	FMG Solomon has developed a new mine and associated infrastructure at its Eliwana Site (Eliwana Project).
	The infrastructure includes 143km of rail and a 30mtpa dry ore processing facility, with production having commenced in December 2020.

	 rock pitching;
	 clearing, grubbing and topsoil stockpiling;
	 structural and non-structural in situ concrete works (e.g. foundations, slabs, blindings etc), concrete repairs and precast concrete works;
	 construction pads, (e.g. crane pads, building pads, laydown areas etc); and
	bridge refurbishment.
