Scope of Work:	The scope of work requires the provision of technically compliant marine vessels to support the Barossa Development Drilling campaign, that will be undertaken using a Semi-Submersible Mobile Offshore Drilling Unit (MODU). The Barossa development wells are located 300 kilometres north of Darwin, Northern Territory, within the Bonaparte Basin in the Timor Sea.
	The drilling support vessels will be required to support the following key activities:
	 Towing of the selected MODU to and from the Barossa drilling location. This requires at least two (2) Anchor Handling, Tug and Supply (AHTS) vessels.
	 Anchor handling operations for the MODU. This requires at least two (2) AHTS vessels.
	 Supply requirements for the MODU during drilling operations. This requires two (2) vessels, that can either be AHTS vessels, or Platform Supply Vessels (PSV), or a mix of vessels.
	AHTS vessels will require sufficient bollard pull (at least 200T) for towing and anchor handling operations, and sufficient deck space (minimum 600m2) for supply operations to be considered technically compliant.
	PSV vessels will require deck space of at least 800m2 to be considered technically compliant.
	The indicative schedule for the tender is as follows (subject to change): a) Issue Tender: Q3 2021 b) Contract Award: Q4 2021 c) Drilling Rig Start Window: Q2-Q3 2022
Objectives:	The main objective for this source of interest and information are to:
	 Enable Santos to gather the latest market information on capable Service Providers for the identified the scope of work.
	 Understand availability of technically compliant AHTS and PSV vessels in the region that can support the scope of work.
