Title: Supply of Diesel Fuel

Scope of Work: The Supplier scope includes the supply, delivery, and offloading of diesel fuel (Product) to the Jobsite throughout the duration of the Project. The total estimated diesel fuel requirement is approx. eleven (11) million litres. It is critical to the Project to maintain uninterrupted supply of Product with a target ten-day (seven-day minimum) reserved, based on near term usage forecasts, stored at Jobsite fuel storage facility. Supplier shall have multiple Product supply origin points and not rely on a single point of origin. Supplier shall maintain a set delivery schedule to ensure a consistent supply of Product. Purchaser shall continually inform Supplier of increased/decreased Product needs to meet Project requirements, and Supplier Product deliveries shall be adjusted accordingly. The Product supplied for this job must comply with the Fuel Quality Standards Act 2000, the Fuel Quality Standards Regulations 2001, and the Fuel Standard (Automotive Diesel) Determination 2001. Assurance that Product meets criteria in these standards shall be provided to Purchaser in accordance with the Supplier's submitted and approved Fuel Assurance Program. Subcontractor shall implement proper dosing of the Product by including proper additives for the minimization of water during transport and storage. All Product delivery drivers shall be certified/licensed to transport dangerous goods (Product) in accordance with applicable Australian laws and regulations, and vehicles used for transporting Product shall be licensed as such. Delivery drivers shall be present at all times during the unloading process to ensure there are no unattended problems (i.e. leaks) during unloading. Deliveries are preferred during normal dayshift working hours, but arrangements may be approved for 24/7 access for deliveries if necessary to ensure adequate supply. Supplier shall prepare and submit for Purchaser's approval a Fuel Assurance Program. This program shall address measures the Supplier will take to ensure the quality, timeliness, and uninterruptable delivery of Product, including contingency and backup plans in the event of disruptions in normal supply chain operations. Supplier shall perform and submit for approval a HAZOP analysis addressing hazards, mitigations, and controls associated with Product delivery and offloading. Supplier shall comply with all applicable Australian / local regulations, statutory requirements, and Australian codes and standards.
