ASC has developed Australia's largest and most complex supply chain operation that supports the Royal Australian Navy.

This has been achieved through the efforts of an experienced supply chain team utilising accredited processes, market-leading quality assurance programs and by creating robust partnerships.

ASC has grown Australian Industry Content in the Collins Class sustainment program to more than 90% and its supply chain team has proven experience managing entire program lifecycles.

ASC's commitment to maximising Australian industry participation includes support for small to medium enterprises through:

- One-on-one coaching to support businesses to meet Defence quality and inspection requirements.

ASC performs Mid Cycle Dockings on the Collins Class fleet at its facilities in Western Australia and Full Cycle Dockings, two-year deep overhauls, are performed at its South Australian facility.

LIFE OF TYPE EXTENSION PROGRAM

ASC is preparing to deliver the Collins Class Submarine's Life of Type Extension (LOTE).

This upgrade will continue the evolution of the fleet and maintain Australia's world-class submarine capability into the 2040s.

ASC's specialist engineers are engaged in the planning phase of the program. Diesel engines and generators will be replaced, major equipment upgraded, and in-depth enhancements carried out across each of the six boats.

The program will integrate leading international technology while maximising Australian industry participation. Global partners include Jeumont, EuroAtlas and Rolls Royce.

Opportunities for Australian suppliers will be available through ASC, and through in-country agents for the major equipment providers. These will be shared on the Industry Capability Network (ICN) Gateway, including work packages to support the Collins propulsion systems update from mid-2022.

ASC will work with its major contractors to maximise Australian industry capability and participation within their projects. This support will include connecting them and their local agencies, to ASC's Australian suppliers.
