Scope of Supply	<p>The Services comprise the supply of Fuel to the Company and its Affiliates at the Company's facilities and operations including but not limited to the following locations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facilities and Operations at Company's Supply facility on the Burrup Peninsula in the North West of Western Australia; • Operations in other locations around Australia from time to time. <p>The major supply item in the performance of the Services is diesel for sea vessels, road vehicles and power generation. The Services include operation and maintenance works of the Company's fuel facilities.</p> <p>The Company objectives to be managed by the Contractor are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contractor is to supply fuel and deliver through the Bulk Liquids Berth and pipeline infrastructure at Company's supply facility to the wharf, tug pens and tank farm facility. • The Contractor is required to bunker vessels on the wharf by connecting the Contractor operated truck to the vessel. • The Contractor is required to facilitate refuelling of the tugs via the tug pen infrastructure. • The Contractor is to deliver fuel to and from tanks on various Company operating sites via truck to support Woodside's operational requirements. • The Contractor will operate the tank farm based at Company's Supply Facility where stocks are held to support Woodside's requirements. • The Contractor will facilitate bunkers at other non-Company operated wharfs if Company requires. • The Contractor will have access to other fuel supplies should a contingency supply be required. • The Contractor will execute and plan all maintenance activities on Company's fuel infrastructure. <p>The contract will allow provisions for alternative fuels such as unleaded fuel, aviation fuel etc. to be supplied and managed through the contract if Company has a requirement for this fuel.</p> <p>There will be provisions within the contract for third parties to be sold fuels by Contractor using Company's facilities, within the constraints of the contract terms.</p> <p>Specific scope requirements will be communicated to suitable Contractors via an Invitation to Tender.</p>
