Project Overview:	Fortescue is developing the Western Hub in the Pilbara region, which includes significant amounts of high iron content bedded iron ore and is home to Fortescue's newest mine, Eliwana. Located 140km to the west of Solomon, Eliwana Operations was commissioned in December 2020, and includes 143km of rail and approximately 30mtpa dry OPF. (Eliwana Project).

Package Description:	 At the time of publishing this invitation to register an interest, the services include installation works related to the following: installation of all goods, equipment, and consumable principal supplied CSP culverts with stabilised backfill in Mining haul roads at multiple locations, diameters ranging from 900mm to 3000mm principal supplied CSP culverts with stabilised backfill on light vehicle roads at multiple locations, diameters ranging from 900mm to 3000mm, construction of roads and drainage. construction and safety management provision of quality associated documentation (MDR, as-builts etc). The performance of the services shall comply with Australian Standards and Fortescue Standard Specifications. The Eliwana Project, including this package FF22OP002C is subject to internal approvals. The procurement process or scope, may change at FMG Solomon's election, including to accommodate project budget and time requirements.
