



WHEATSTONE OPERATIONS

TITLE: C1245797 – Platform Supply Vessels

DESCRIPTION: Chevron Australia (Company) requires two Platform Supply Vessels (PSV) for the Wheatstone Project both capable of Safety Standby Vessel (SSV) and general supply vessel activities on a 24/7 basis, fully manned, compliant with all necessary Company policies, procedures and standards.

The vessels will be required to commence in 2015 (currently envisaged to March / April 2015) for the Phase 4 Hook up and Commissioning (HUC) campaign before transitioning into Phase 5 operations at the completion of the HUC scope in the first quarter of 2016.

Vessels will be used to perform the same duties for the HUC campaign and Phase 5 Operations. The only differentiating factor will be the frequency and quantities of both cargo and fuel to be collected on a weekly basis.

Both vessels are to be capable, manned and equipped for both safety standby operations or cargo supply runs between the Wheatstone Platform and port of Dampier, Western Australia or other Company designated port or facility.

Vessels must meet or exceed Australian standards with regard to certification of crews, manning levels and accommodation standards, AQUIS and all other applicable Australian regulation and legislations.

The vessels required will be used to carry out:

- 24/7 operations;
- Supply runs between the Port in Dampier and Wheatstone Platform and other Company designated locations;
- Fuel collection/transfer from the nominated bunkering facility in Dampier and other Company designated locations;
- Safety standby duties; and
- Any other services within the vessel capability that may be requested.
