Package Description	<p>Subsea 7's (on behalf of the Subsea Integration Alliance) scope of work for Scarborough Project involves the project management, engineering, procurement, fabrication and installation of the various Subsea Umbilicals, Risers and Flowlines (SURF) equipment:</p> <p>The scope of supply for the Subsea Umbilicals, Risers and Flowlines (SURF) will require various offshore support vessels during operations. The nature of the offshore support will be:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Crew Boat A crew boat is required to take up to 20pax between Dampier Port and Subsea7 Vessels at anchorage. The vessel will be needed during offshore operations between Q4 2023-Q1 2025. Crew transfer of up to 6 or 12 pax is also expected between Dampier Port, Heavy Lift Vessels and Subsea7 Construction Vessels anchored both within port limits These 2 requirements can be met by the same vessel or separate vessels. 2) PSV for Vessel Support To provide food/fuel/jet fuel/waste and equipment transfers services between Dampier Port, Heavy Lift Vessels and Subsea7 Construction Vessels anchored both within port limits between throughout Subsea7's offshore operations phase between Q4 2023-Q1 2025. 3) PSV for MEG transport (Potential Scope) The PSV shall be capable of storing, transporting and transferring (to Subsea7's vessel) between 100 to 300 m3 of MEG in internal tanks (Brine / MEG tanks). <p>General Vessel Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vessel Inspection: MWS and/or OVID • Safety Management & HSE: to meets the projects safety objectives <p>Mandatory requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Supplier must have <u>confirmed access</u> to vessel if not owned. <u>Preference will be given to vessel owners.</u> • <u>Please provide vessel particulars/brochure when responding to this enquiry.</u>
