



## ABU – PRODUCTION OPERATIONS

**TITLE:** C1286921 – Provision of Hire Cranes

**DESCRIPTION:** Chevron Australia is seeking expressions of interest for the provision of hire cranes for Company's Australasia Strategic Business Unit (ABU) including but not limited to Wheatstone LNG Facility and Company operated mainland facilities and any Contractor operated facility that is used for the provision of Services.

The Services will include:

- Dry hire cranes (for use by maintenance contractor drivers):
  - 2 x 20t Franna cranes or equivalent to be available
  - 1 x 70t all-terrain crane or equivalent
- Wet hire cranes:
  - 1 x 90t all-terrain crane or equivalent
  - 1 x 500t crane

All cranes are predominantly to be used on a 12 hour day shift basis, but may be required on a night shift, so provision for extra drivers needs to be allowed.

Lift studies have identified a requirement for a 90t and 500t crane. However, with respect to the 90t requirement, a suitable, more readily available larger crane may be preferred.

It is preferred that these wet hire cranes will be used on a planned basis, but during a breakdown scenario a crane would need to be mobilized to site within 4 hours.

- Opportunity work:

On a day to day basis, particularly during start-up and commissioning, there may also be a need for alternate sized cranes to be mobilised at very short notice.

- Shutdown work:

During shutdowns it is anticipated there may be a requirement for a number of large sized cranes. It is envisaged these shutdowns will be done on a planned basis, with notice given to the Contractor to supply required cranes. Contractor will be expected to source cranes from other contractors if unable to supply requirements, at the same rates as agreed by the contract

- Crane maintenance:

All crane maintenance will be carried out by the Contractor and replacement cranes supplied if needs to be taken out of service.

- Driver competencies:

Contractor will be responsible for ensuring driver competency meets or exceeds Chevron's verification of competency requirements, is up to date and available on demand to Chevron as required.
