2. INDICATIVE SCOPE OF WORK	
Package Description	<p>Overview</p> <p><i>Saipem Australia Pty Ltd and Clough Projects Australia Pty Ltd Joint Venture (herein referred to as the "CONTRACTOR") has reached an agreement with Perdaman Chemicals and Fertilisers Pty Ltd (herein referred to as the "OWNER") for the Engineering, Procurement, Construction and Commissioning of the BURRUP UREA PROJECT.</i></p> <p><i>Perdaman Chemicals and Fertilisers Pty Ltd (OWNER) is focused on the development of the Perdaman Project which shall be the world's largest gas stream ammonia-urea plant with a production capacity of 2.14 MMTPA granular urea. The plant is located within the Burrup Strategic Industrial Area, Burrup Peninsula, approximately 10 km from Dampier and 20 km north-west of Karratha on the Northwest coastline of Western Australia.</i></p>

General Scope of Supply / Services

Provision by the Medical Service Operator (SUBCONTRACTOR) for all necessary supervision, labour, expertise, materials, equipment, and services required to provide Medical Services (WORKS).

In general, the SUBCONTRACTOR shall be responsible for all aspects of Medical Services, including but not limited to the following:

- Medical emergencies and crisis management.
- Medical services including personnel, clinic set up, maintenance and provision of required equipment.
- Management of Fitness for Work.
- Mobilisation and demobilisation of all equipment and personnel to/from site.
- FIFO costs for rotation of the medical staff.
- Even time roster for medical staff.
- Start-up consumables including drugs and other medical supplies for the clinic and patient transfer vehicle.
- Detailed advice as to the basic size and design of clinics as per Project requirements.
- Responsibilities for fit out of the clinic equipment (equipment supplied by medical provider).
- Approved lockable Dangerous Goods cabinet for scheduled medications.
- Training of the workforce during Toolbox Talks (fitness for work, STD etc.) and the provision of posters and information material.

SCJV to Provide (Exclusions):

- Fully heated and air-conditioned Medical clinic modules complete with utilities and services compliant with NCC.
- Medical centre complete with covered patient transport vehicle bay utilities and services compliant with NCC.
- Mechanical servicing of 4WD ambulance.
- Minor non-critical repairs of 4WD ambulance.
- Onsite fuel for 4WD ambulance.
- Poisons license.
- Potable water.
- Personnel accommodation and messing.
- Crib facilities whilst onsite.
- Bussing and travel onsite.

Subcontractor to Provide (Inclusions):

- Advice on layout of medical clinics.
- Undertake the treatment of first aid, serious injuries and illness.

- Provision of alcohol testing for confirmatory testing in accordance with AS 3547-2019.
