Description	Saipem Australia Pty Ltd and Clough Projects Australia Pty Ltd Joint Venture (herein referred to as the "CONTRACTOR") has reached an agreement with Perdaman Chemicals and Fertilisers Pty Ltd (herein referred to as the "OWNER") for the Engineering, Procurement, Construction and Commissioning of the BURRUP UREA PROJECT.	
	Perdaman Chemicals and Fertilisers Pty Ltd (OWNER) is focused on the development of the Perdaman Project which shall be the world's largest gas stream ammonia-urea plant with a production capacity of 2.14 MMTPA granular urea. The plant is located within the Burrup Strategic Industrial Area, Burrup Peninsula, approximately 10 km from Dampier and 20 km north-west of Karratha on the Northwest coastline of Western Australia.	

General Scope of Supply / Services

Provision of Waste Management services including all necessary supervision, labour, expertise, materials, equipment, documentation and services.

In general, the SUBCONTRACTOR shall be responsible for all aspects of waste collection, management, and disposal from the site, including but not limited to the following:

- Collection of waste materials from nominated locations onsite.
- Transport of waste materials to offsite location(s) for disposal and treatment (as appropriate).
- Mobilising and servicing waste bins and containers to site.
- · Sorting of waste streams.
- Providing recycling services to the applicable waste streams.
- Operation of Subcontractor waste management laydown yard.
- Mobilising, operating and servicing mobile equipment required for waste management as appropriate (Front Lift Truck, Skip Truck, Liquid Vacuum Truck, Liquid Vacuum Tanker, Truck and Trailer, Hook Lift Truck, Hook Lift Truck, etc. as required)
- Provision of operators and supervisors onsite as required.
- Septic collection onsite and offsite treatment and disposal.
- Onsite transport of SUBCONTRACTOR personnel.

SCJV to Provide (Exclusions)

- Onsite fuel for vehicles and equipment permanently located onsite.
- Maintenance servicing for vehicles and equipment permanently located onsite.
- Potable water.
- Personnel accommodation and messing.
- Crib facilities whilst onsite.
- Bussing onsite.

Subcontractor to Provide (Inclusions)

- Collection, management and disposal of solid and liquid waste from site.
 This includes, but is not limited to: General waste, Construction waste,
 Septic, Medical waste, Coolants, Degreaser, Grease, Waste oil, Oily water,
 Grease traps, Pallets, Drums, IBC's, Contaminated soil, Tyres, and
 Controlled waste.
- Operators, supervisors, and administration required for both the onsite management and offsite disposal of waste.
- Waste bins and containers required for the collection and management of waste.
- Major repairs and offline coverage for vehicles and equipment permanently located onsite.
