2. INDICATIVE SCOPE OF WORK		
Package Description	Overview Saipem Australia Pty Ltd and Clough Projects Australia Pty Ltd Joint Venture (herein referred to as the "CONTRACTOR") has reached an agreement with Perdaman Chemicals and Fertilisers Pty Ltd (herein referred to as the "OWNER") for the Engineering, Procurement, Construction and Commissioning of the BURRUP UREA PROJECT. Perdaman Chemicals and Fertilisers Pty Ltd (OWNER) is focused on the development of the Perdaman Project which shall be the world's largest gas stream ammonia-urea plant with a production capacity of 2.14 MMTPA granular urea. The plant is located within the Burrup Strategic Industrial Area, Burrup Peninsula, approximately 10 km from Dampier and 20 km north-west of Karratha on the Northwest coastline of Western Australia.	

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General Scope of Supply / Services

SUBCONTRACTOR shall provide all resources, services and necessary equipment to supply the Onsite, concrete mixing & delivery service, at locations required within the project boundaries.

SUBCONTRACTOR shall (unless otherwise noted) provide all management, supervision, labor, procurement, fuels, equipment, tools, consumables, material supplies and all accessories required for supply and delivery of Concrete, at the point of discharge, within project boundary.

The supply also includes, but is not limited to, the supporting management, administrative and other requirements described in the Inquiry Package.

SCJV to Provide (Exclusions)

- Concrete Supply at site (excluding pumping).
- Onsite fuel for vehicles and equipment permanently located onsite.
- Potable water.
- Personnel accommodation and messing.
- · Crib facilities whilst onsite.
- Bussing onsite.

- Temporary roads, walkways, hardstands as required for the construction
 works.
- Permanent roads (except Asphalting works), Embankments and Ponds.
- Manholes, Catch basins, Cleanouts and Sumps.
- Paved areas, hard stands and walkways.
- Unpaved area finishes.
- Drain pits and RCC Pipes.
- Temporary drainage and stormwater management.
- Culverts, E&I Cable Trenches and Duct banks.
- Sleepers, lightpole, signage foundations and Kerbs
- Demolition/reconstruction (Wherever applicable).
- Structural & General fill including compaction.
- Grouting (Cementitious and Epoxy).
- Hardstand developments.
- Fire proofing.
