Harmony Overview	<p>Harmony is a 70-year-old mining company headquartered in South Africa and listed on the Johannesburg and New York stock exchanges.</p> <p>In December 2022, Harmony acquired 100% of the Eva Copper Mine Project (“EVAMP”), a near-term copper project in North-West Queensland, Australia.</p> <p>Harmony is updating the feasibility study and progressing front end engineering definition prior to a final investment decision (FID). Once FID is achieved construction is expected to take approximately 24 months.</p>
Project Overview:	<p>Eva Copper Mine Project (EVAMP) is a multi-open pit sulphide and native copper mine producing a copper concentrate. The current feasibility assumes 240 million tonnes of ore. The copper concentrator will process copper concentrate through a conventional crushing, milling, gravity, and flotation plant, for the life-of-mine (LOM) duration.</p>
Scoping Precip:	<p>A supplier is required to construct 6m wide access tracks (including localised widening to accommodate heavy vehicle turning movement) to support Early Works along the mine access road, accommodation village area and construction laydown areas.</p> <p>Note: the access track work is to be done generally over the existing access track with varying widths.</p>
Specific Requirements	<p>The selected Supplier is required to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Install silt erosion and sediment fencing b) Clear and grub (where required) the area of vegetation along alignment. c) Remove cleared vegetation to a nominated stockpile location. d) Construct 6m wide access track including localised widening up to 10m wide at turnings. e) Supply and lay 100mm crushed rock pavement over a layer of geofabric at nominated sections of the track f) Constructed localised buried HDPE drainage crossing overtopped with crushed rocks protection at nominated drainage crossings. <p>The selected Supplier is expected to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Display a strong local presence that maximises opportunities for local personnel and businesses within the surrounding region. b) Work closely with the EVAMP team and the Traditional Owners of the land, the Kalkadoon people, to maximise opportunities for employment and training development. c) Comply with all the EVAMP policies and regulatory approvals issued. d) Undertake the works in accordance with the EVAMP Safety and Health Management System and all of its provisions in accordance with the Mining and Quarrying Safety and Health Act and Regulations, and all Environmental permits.
