Harmony Overview	Harmony is a 70-year-old mining company headquartered in South Africa and listed on the Johannesburg and New York stock exchanges.
	In December 2022, Harmony acquired 100% of the Eva Copper Mine Project ("EVAMP"), a near-term copper project in North-West Queensland, Australia.
	Harmony is updating the feasibility study and progressing front end engineering definition prior to a final investment decision (FID). Once FID is achieved construction is expected to take approximately 24 months.
Project Overview:	Eva Copper Mine Project (EVAMP) is a multi-open pit sulphide and native copper mine that will produce a copper concentrate. The current feasibility assumes 240 million tonnes of ore. The copper concentrator will process copper concentrate through a conventional crushing, milling, gravity, and flotation plant, for the life- of-mine (LOM) duration.
	In parallel with Feasibility Update studies currently underway, the company is investigating resource growth upside for the project through resource definition and regional exploration drilling
Scoping Precis:	A drilling services provider with proven RC and deep diamond drilling capacity is sought for an extension of the current drill program. Since acquiring the project and commencing drilling in March 2023, over 63,000m has been drilled utilising 2 multipurpose rigs and a dedicated diamond drill rig.
	Harmony anticipate drilling a further 60,000m in CY2024, as part of developing orebody knowledge across all 12 of the Roseby Copper deposits (located on the EVAMP Mining Leases) and commencement of regional drill programs to test various prospect areas on the surrounding EPMs.
Specific Requirements	The selected Supplier is required to provide quality modern drilling rigs and ancillary equipment with advanced engineered safety controls. The selected supplier will also have a demonstrable record of leading safety performance in drilling operations, underpinned by an established Safety, Health, Environment, Management Plan and safety culture. Specific program aspects include:
	 a) 5 ½ inch diameter RC drill holes and precollars up to 400m depth. Dayshift RC drilling only
	 b) Diamond drill (triple tube) for planned depths up to 1300m. HQ3 core is preferred. PQ3 from surface and NQ3 (as rig capacity dictates) may be required. Oriented HQ & NQ core + down hole gyro surveys required. Diamond drilling will be double shift
	c) 14/7 roster for drilling conducted on the Mining Leases
	 d) Currently there are no accommodation facilities established onsite. Supplier to provide camp accommodation for drill crews and supervisors. Water required is sourced from established bores.
	The selected Supplier is expected to:
	 Display a strong local presence that maximises opportunities for local personnel and businesses within the surrounding region.
	 b) Work closely with the EVAMP team and the Traditional Owners of the land, the Kalkadoon people, to maximise opportunities for employment and training development.

	 c) Comply with all the EVAMP policies and regulatory approvals issued. d) Undertake the works in accordance with the EVAMP Safety and Health Management System and all of its provisions in accordance with the Mining and Quarrying Safety and Health Act and Regulations, and all Environmental permits.
