2. INDICATIVE SCOPE OF WORK	
Package Description	<p>Overview</p> <p>Saipem Australia Pty Ltd and Clough Projects Australia Pty Ltd Joint Venture (herein referred to as the "CONTRACTOR") has reached an agreement with Perdaman Chemicals and Fertilisers Pty Ltd (herein referred to as the "OWNER") for the Engineering, Procurement, Construction and Commissioning of the BURRUP UREA PROJECT.</p> <p>Perdaman Chemicals and Fertilisers Pty Ltd (OWNER) is focused on the development of the Perdaman Project which shall be the world's largest gas stream ammonia-urea plant with a production capacity of 2.14 MMTPA granular urea. The plant is located within the Burrup Strategic Industrial Area, Burrup Peninsula, approximately 10 km from Dampier and 20 km north-west of Karratha on the Northwest coastline of Western Australia.</p>

General Scope of Supply / Services**1. SCOPE OF SUPPLY**

The SUBCONTRACTOR shall quote for the supply of approx. 12M litres of Diesel Fuel, Bulk Storage on site and refuelling facilities for 1 or both Project Sites, C & F, for both passenger and commercial Construction Equipment along with provision of a mobile refuelling service for heavy equipment onsite.

The Service will also include the provision of a Fuel Management System which will be able to provide accurate reporting per User/ Subcontractor of individual Equipment fuel utilisation along with any over utilisation or anomaly reporting and an inbuilt security system to ensure zero theft of fuel.

Subcontractor will be able to provide all labour, supervision, materials, equipment, tools, supplies and services required by the Contractor to maintain constant fuel supply to all Equipment on site.

This Scope of Work (SOW) specifies the extent of work required for the Supply and Installation of refuelling services for the construction phase of Perdaman Urea Plant, including mobilisation, site installation, commissioning, maintenance decommissioning and demobilisation.

The requirements detailed within this SOW dictate the minimum standards required with respect to technical compliance, quality, and safety. General industry codes and standards may be admissible only when they equal or exceed the detailed requirements herein.

Any discrepancy identified by the SUBCONTRACTOR between the CONTRACTOR's requirements and the referenced documentation shall be brought to the attention of the CONTRACTOR in writing.

Under all circumstances, the SUBCONTRACTOR shall comply with all prevailing Federal, State or Local Government Authority legislation and regulations.

The SUBCONTRACTORs proposal will be to include both pricing to purchase and pricing to rent temporary facilities for the project.

SUBCONTRACTOR is also encouraged to put forward any other options that would be beneficial to the CONTRACTOR. SOW is inclusive of the furnishing of all labour, supervision, overhead, materials, equipment, tools, supplies, and services required to ensure a reliable Fuel Supply for the duration of the Project.
