TITLE:

EOI 24 - Provision of Quarantine Services

DESCRIPTION:

An Expression of Interest (EOI) is sought from industry to undertake quarantine services in accordance with the Barrow Island (BWI) Terrestrial and Marine Quarantine Management System (QMS).

The QMS governs all materials, personnel, vessels and aircraft travelling to, or transferring via BWI, or the surrounding waters. The specific objectives of the QMS are to:

- Prevent the introduction of Non-indigenous Terrestrial Species and Marine Pests;
- Detect Non-indigenous Terrestrial Species and Marine Pests;
- Control and, unless otherwise determined, eradicate detected Non-indigenous Terrestrial Species and Marine Pests;
- Mitigate adverse impacts of any control and eradication actions on indigenous species taken against detected Non-indigenous Terrestrial Species and Marine Pests:
- The QMS comprises guidelines, procedures, specifications and checklists organised within a hierarchical structure, with each tier of documents supporting the one preceding it.

An EOI is sought from industry demonstrating infrastructure, internal systems (processes and procedures) and organisational capability to undertake red tag quarantine services on general cargo, including containerised or crated equipment/materials, skid, steel or loose equipment, plant or mobile equipment (complex and non-complex), air freight and special and sensitive equipment destined for Barrow Island. The services to be provided may include the following:

- Remediation of cargo to remove risk material;
- Provision of quarantine treatments including the ability to undertake remedial fumigation;
- Ability to shrink wrap, crate or containerise equipment;
- Infrastructure to support the above activities (e.g. certified pallet/container inspection stands, wash pad).

Applicants will be required to provide documented processes addressing the following criteria:

- Existing vegetation and weed control program;
- Existing pest/rodent control program;

- Ability to segregate Barrow Island cargo from other operations;
- Delineated cargo receipt and red/blue tag areas isolated from potential sources of quarantine risk;
- Record management;
- Audit or internal compliance monitoring;
- Barrow Island red tag accredited personnel.

Businesses will be assessed against these criteria to ensure the facility, internal systems, infrastructure and organisational capability meets the requirements.
