Preference is to have one Contractor who is able to provide a range of freight forwarding services to support Chevron for:

- Routine procurement activities for operational and maintenance requirements;
- Periodic turnaround / shutdowns; and
- Minor capital projects.

Primary services required are as follows:

- Freight forwarding services;
- Pick Up Cargo, Receiving / accepting cargo, handling, cargo documentation, unloading, inspecting and Material receipt preparation;
- Warehousing and Storage, Facility and Documentation;
- Consolidation/ Packing: Marking and Labelling;
- Shipment;
- Customs Clearance and Compliance with Law and regulation;
- Local Transportation;
- Port, Logistics and Procurement Services;
- Shipping Documentation;
- Loss Damage Prevention; and
- Tracking and Expediting and Other Services.

Key roles and responsibilities undertaken to include (during steady state operations):

- Researching, planning and selecting the most appropriate route for a shipment, taking responsibility for the type of Cargo, cost, transit time and security;
- Arranging appropriate packing, repacking & delivery of Cargo to final destination;
- Obtaining, checking and preparing documentation to meet customs and insurance requirements, packing specifications and compliance with applicable host country regulations;
- Consolidation services by air, sea and road, ensuring effective cost and space utilization;
- Liaising with subcontractor to move cargo by Air, Sea and Road in accordance with Company requirement;
- Liaison with shipper/consignee and/or their nominated agents;
- Arranging insurance and assisting the Company in the event of a Company claim against service shipping lines, airlines or road operator;
