- Provision of and/or access to a fit for purpose valve test and repair facility/workshop with lifting facilities;
- Valve diagnostic services;
- Valve assembly and quality inspections;
- Capability to mobilise personnel at short notice (within 12 hours) for maintenance and breakdown support 24 hours per day, 365 days per year;
- Provision of 24 hour engineering support telephone help line in Australia;
- Understanding of valve criticality and valve integrity;
- ISO 9001:2015 accreditation;
- Repair recommendations and engineering support;
- Performing root cause analysis and reporting on all valve failures;
- Storage and warehousing of valves at Contractor's WA premises;
- Procurement services for replacement valves and new valves:
- Recordkeeping;
- Ability to provide evidence for materials traceability and positive material identification (PMI);

Development of a management plan for chemical-impacted valves;

• Understanding of valve preservation techniques and storage best practice; and

Ability to work collaboratively and build relationships with the incumbent Company valve contractors.
